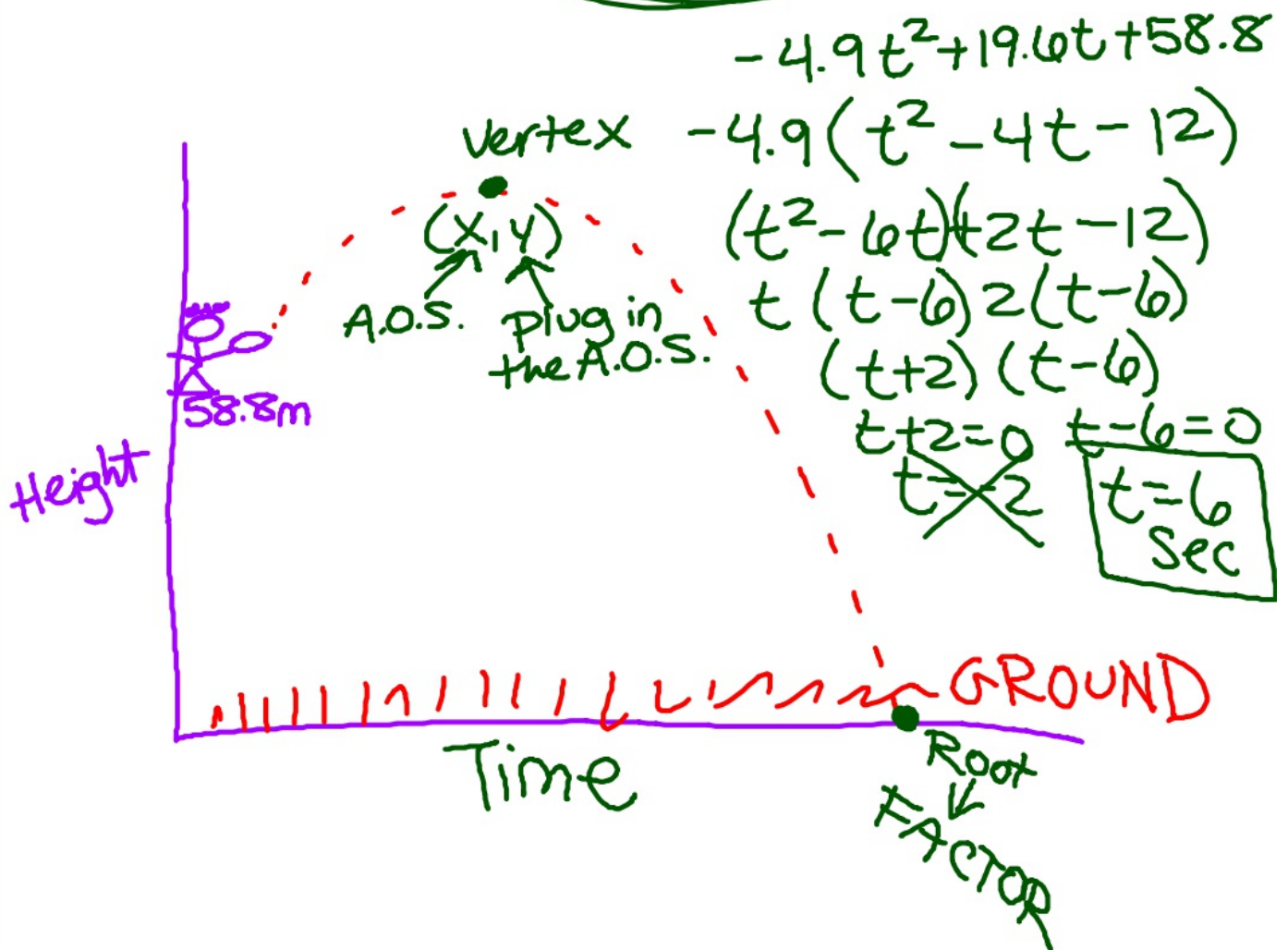

An object is launched at 19.6 meters per second (m/s) from a 58.8-meter tall platform. The equation for the object's height s at time t seconds after launch is

$s(t) = -4.9t^2 + 19.6t + 58.8$, where s is in meters. When does the object strike the ground? Root

Jason jumped off of a cliff into the ocean in Acapulco while vacationing with some friends. His height as a function of time could be modeled by the function $h(t) = -16t^2 + 16t + 480$, where t is the time in seconds and h is the height in feet.

a. How long did it take for Jason to reach his maximum height?

Example 4:

Jocelyn and Kelly built rockets from assembly kits and are going to launch them at the same time to see whose rocket flies higher. If Jocelyn's rocket's height, in feet, can be described by the equation $J(x) = -16x^2 + 256x$ while Kelly's is represented by $K(x) = -16x^2 + 288x$.

- Who wins the rocket race? (What is the max height for both rockets?) vertex y
