1. Determine whether the relation  
 $\{(7, 2), (-10, 3), (-5, -1), (7, 3)\}$  is a function. Explain.

Can't have NO  
repeating x-values

2. Find  $f(-6)$  if  $f(x) = -2x + 20$

$$-2(-6) + 20$$

$$f(-6) = 32 \quad (-6, 32)$$

3. Solve:  $14 - x = x + 60$

$$\begin{array}{r} -x \\ \hline -14 \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 14 - 2x = 60 \\ -14 \\ \hline -2x = 46 \\ -2 \\ \hline x = -23 \end{array}$$

$$14 - (-23) = -23 + 60$$

$$37 = 37$$

4. Solve:  $10 - 3(3x + 5) > 26$

$$10 - 3(3x + 5) > 26$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 10 - 3(3x + 5) > 26 \\ 10 - 15 - 9x > 26 \\ -5 - 9x > 26 \\ -9x > 31 \\ x < -\frac{31}{9} \end{array}$$

$$x < -\frac{31}{9}$$

$$\frac{\text{rise}}{\text{run}}$$

Four types of slope:


- Positive
- Negative
- Zero slope
- Undefined

$$\frac{y_2 - y_1}{x_2 - x_1}$$



$$\frac{\text{rise}}{\text{run}}$$


Use when given a graph and asked to find slope




$$\begin{aligned}\text{rise} &= 2 \\ \text{run} &= 1\end{aligned}$$

$$\text{slope} = 2$$

$$m = 2$$



$$\frac{-3}{3} = -1 \quad m = -1$$




$$m = \frac{3}{4}$$







When given two points, you find the slope by using the formula:

$$m = \frac{y_2 - y_1}{x_2 - x_1}$$

$(x_1, y_1)$

$(x_2, y_2)$

1.  $x_1, y_1, x_2, y_2$   
 $(-4, 7), (-10, 9)$

$$m = \frac{9-7}{-10+4} = \frac{2}{-6} = -\frac{1}{3}$$

3.  $(-5, -4), (-5, 10)$

$$m = \frac{10+4}{-5+5} = \frac{14}{0} \quad m = \phi$$

5.  $(3, 10), (-15, 4)$

$$m = \frac{4-10}{-15-3} = \frac{-6}{-18} = \boxed{\frac{1}{3}}$$

2.  $x_1, y_1, x_2, y_2$   
 $(12, 6), (-2, 10)$

$$m = \frac{10-6}{-2-12} = \frac{4}{-14} = \boxed{-\frac{2}{7}}$$

4.  $(6, -2), (0, -5)$

$$m = \frac{-5+2}{0-6} = \frac{-3}{-6} = \boxed{\frac{1}{2}}$$

6.  $(0, 9), (-16, 9)$

$$m = \frac{9-9}{-16-0} = \frac{0}{-16} = 0$$

$$\boxed{m=0}$$
